New H-1B Legislation Is Designed Specifically To Give High-Tech Foreign Workers The Advantage Over American Workers.

These foreign workers can be hired for one-third to one-half less than Americans. So, greedy corporations are bribing Congress with campaign contributions to pass the law as quickly as possible before you have time to do anything about it.

- In 1998, he voted to double the number of foreign high-tech workers
- Opposed a law in 1996 requiring employers to verify if the people they hire have a legal right to work in this country
- Co-sponsored a law giving amnesty to over 600,000 illegal aliens from Latin America
- Pushed legislation in 1990 to dramatically increase all categories of immigrants coming to the U.S.
- Voted in 1996 to continue chain migration, the primary reason immigration has swollen from 300,000 to over 1,000,000 a year
